SIR JOHN PHILIPPS, 6<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

1701-1764

This very large monument is one of several relating to the Philipps family of Picton Castle which can be found in St Mary's Church, the civic church of Haverfordwest.

Sir John was a very prominent man in the country and a member of one of the most powerful families in Pembrokeshire which exerted enormous political, social and economic influence over all aspects of life.

The monument is now in a dangerous and unsafe state. It was propped with scaffolding for safety in 2015. It needs to be dismantled, repaired and refixed.

Tenders have been received. The cheapest was submitted by Sally Strachey Historic Conservation of Wells. The cost, including the scaffolding which has been supporting the monument, will be in the region of £12,500.

**The Church Council is appealing for help towards raising this sum which has to be done before work can commence. Any contribution will be gratefully received**
